For over 50 years, local historian Barbara Rumsey reminded one and all of the value of "their" historical society and the need to support its efforts through donations of funds or items of local historical significance. Thanks to Barbara, the museum now holds well over 30,000 photographs, documents, and artifacts of local interest.
